Appendix K

Explicit Mitzvot of the New Covenant Shlichim

Whereas New Covenant Scriptures are liberally cited in support of *Mitzvot* elsewhere in this book, this Appendix lists those words of the *Shlichim* that were spoken in the imperative and can therefore be considered commandments in their own right.
